



Alcohol Service Policy

The Stone Hearth Inn is committed to the responsible service of alcoholic beverages. We are dedicated to upholding Vermont State Law and the regulations set forth by the Vermont Liquor Commission. Our staff is trained to recognize intoxicated behavior and to limit or refuse service if necessary.

No guest under the age of 21, or who appears to be under 21 and cannot produce an ID, will be served or be allowed to consume alcohol. Acceptable proof is a valid photo driver's license, passport, or military ID.

The staff must know who is consuming an alcoholic beverage therefore only one drink will be served per person.

No guest who appears to be intoxicated will be served. We reserve the right to suspend service during any function where, in our opinion, the Stone Hearth Inn's liquor license or the comfort and safety of our guests may be in jeopardy.

No alcoholic beverages may be removed from the premises or consumed outside the designated areas for consumption
